

## Fly Ride Adventure – Morocco with Biketruck

Completely bespoke five-day exclusive motorcycle adventure - led by *Billy Ward* and *Wheels of Morocco* - who have ridden thousands of kilometres around the globe – truly experienced adventure riders, guides and instructors.

The tour will loop from Marrakesh south to Taroudant and Ouarzazate before returning back to Marrakesh.

**Location:** Marrakech, Morocco – Arrival/Departure Airport is ‘Menara’

**Tour Distance:** Approx. 750km

**Highlights:** Marrakech - Jamaa el Fna Square, Atlas Mountains, Taroudant, Ouarzazate, Film Studios, Ait Benhaddou, Tizi n'Test Pass, Tizi n'Tichka pass

**Roads:** Predominantly tarmac, some broken tar and fallen sandy gravel, road works, some gravel options available – we are flexible for the groups needs and capabilities

**Training:** If required both Billy and crew can offer basic gravel training. If the group want to do some gravel trails we can arrange – flexible

**Skill Level:** Any competent, confident rider with full motorcycle license

**Hotels:** Good Quality. Dinner Bed & Breakfast - 4 nights. Twin Share

**Support Vehicle:** And driver carrying luggage, medical kit, tools, water etc.

**Guides:** Billy Ward + BMW Certified Guide / Multilingual Instructor / Guide with expert in country knowledge.

**Bikes / Rental:** Late model BMW's Adventure range

**Tour Includes:** Airport Transfer, Info pack / gift, Photos, Hotels, Bike Hire & Insurance, Support Vehicle, Tolls, Parking, Unlimited Mileage, Taxes, Guides

**Damage Deposit:** There is a returnable damage deposit which can be paid in Morocco or home country. Your bike will be inspected before and after the tour and any damage to the bike will be taken from your deposit - to cover repair.

*Deposit rates are: BMW 800 = €1600 / BMW 1200 = €1800*

## Fly Ride Adventure in Morocco – Some info

Hi all, thanks for your reservation, here is some more information to whet your appetite and answer some of your questions.

- 1. Riding Gear:** We recommend 'Adventure' style riding gear & boots either enduro or supportive adventure boots. Your suit should have armour and protection. We can arrange kit hire if required.
- 2. Luggage:** Your overnight bag should be soft 35/40 litre roll bag max – to fit in our support vehicle. Large luggage will remain at hotel till we return on our loop. We can loan you a roll bag if required.
- 3. Helmet:** Recommend full-face adventure helmet with visor or goggles
- 4. Tank Bags:** We can hire, Top box or Tank Bags – please ask
- 5. Rental Contract:** We will need a scan of your passport, driver's license and medical / travel insurance before your arrival
- 6. Driver's License:** You will need to bring your valid driver's license to Morocco for checking or in case of police checks
- 7. Immigration:** When entering Morocco, you will fill in an immigration form. Please use hotel address: *Adam Park, Avenue de Teme Art, Marrakech.*
- 8. Currency:** Morocco uses the Dirham (MAD) but US Dollars and Euros are accepted in big establishments. We advise to use local currency. You can only get Dirhams in Morocco – bank, hotel or ATM
- 9. Credit Cards:** Usually taken in most high end venues e.g. Hotels
- 10. Medical / Travel Insurance:** You need medical insurance that covers repatriation / cancellation. Specify to your broker that you're riding a motorcycle of 700cc or more. Some policies only cover up to 125cc.
- 11. Medication:** Please bring any specific personal medication e.g. inhalers
- 12. Visa:** Please check if you need a visa – this is your responsibility. British Nationals do not need a visa
- 13. Hotels:** Although quality is generally good, accommodation and service may not be up to Western European standards – please be patient

# Fly Ride Adventure in Morocco – Itinerary 750k

## Day 1: Arrival

Arrival Marrakech. We recommend you arrive early or the day before as we have planned activities late afternoon. Taxi to hotel, where you will be able to settle in and relax by the pool to prepare for the ride next morning. Welcome briefing and the formalities – bike handover, license check etc.

## Day 2: Marrakech – Taroudant (250 km)

The first riding day is awesome as we head south across the Atlas Mountains through the infamous *Tizi n'Test* pass towards Taroudant. Twisty with lots of switchbacks climbing over 2,000 metres before descending towards our destination. A pleasant walk into the local souk before dinner and a few beers back at the hotel!

## Day 3: Taroudant – Ouarzazate (300 km)

This morning we ride the south side of the Atlas range along incredible roads towards a famous southern Moroccan town - Ouarzazate. If time, maybe a look at one of the local film studios should round the day off. Our hotel is a great place to end the days adventure. Get ready for a good dinner, Moroccan style.

## Day 4: Ouarzazate – Marrakech (230 km)

Before tackling the high mountain pass to the north, we will visit the UNESCO heritage site of *Ait Benhaddou*, the scene of many a good movie – *Gladiator* and *Babel* to name a couple. Then we cross the Atlas once again, using one of Morocco's best-known pass's – the *Tizi n'Tichka*. Upon our arrival to our hotel in Marrakech you will hand over the bikes before heading to the city to explore the medina with its souks and the vibrant *Jamaa el Fna square* with snake charmers, spices and food stalls. Pretty cool place for our final dinner!

## Day 5: Departure Marrakech

Depending on your flight time, you can chill and relax or nip into the city for some presents. Your transfers will take you to the airport as per your individual flight time. We know you'll now start planning your next Moroccan adventure!
